<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Doubled the size of the United States</li><li>• Purchased from France</li><li>• Cost less than \$.03 an acre</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adams-Onís Treaty</li><li>• Set a boundary between US and New Spain</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• After gaining independence from Mexico, become their own country for 9 years</li><li>• Eventually Congress admits this territory to the Union as a state</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 54° 40' or Fight</li><li>• Race to get more people there than British</li><li>• Conestoga wagons</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Try to purchase land to Rio Grande River, but Mexico refuses</li><li>• General Zachary Taylor sent to area</li><li>• Ends with Treaty of Guadalupe-Hidalgo (disputed TX Territory and New Mexico and CA)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provides land for a southern transcontinental railroad</li><li>• Resolves issues from US-Mexican War</li></ul>
